Flu Vaccinations: All Lots must be fully Vaccinated in accordance with BHA guidelines. All horses must have at least two primary injections to be given not less than Twenty-one (21) and not more than ninety-two (92) days apart. A booster injection should be given not less than one hundred and fifty (150) and not more than two hundred and fifteen (215) days apart. Thereafter one injection should be given annually. All injections should be recorded in the passport
