

Goffs UK September Sale 2022 - VENDOR INFORMATION

- **PASSPORTS** – All passports must have up to date vaccinations in line with BHA regulations. It is not necessary to email passport details prior to sale.
 - **GOFFS UK 30 DAY HEALTH DECLARATION** – ALL lots must be accompanied by a declaration and printed on your veterinary practice headed paper (PDF Format), signed and dated **within 30 days of the sale** by your Veterinary Surgeon whilst the Vendor must also sign and confirm the Declaration of Residence.
 - **EQUINE INFECTIOUS ANAEMIA (EIA)** – **It is mandatory** that ALL horses are presented for sale with an EIA (Coggins) test dated **within 70 days of the sale** and analysed by APHA Weybridge Laboratory or an approved EU laboratory. (Please note the Irish Equine Centre Laboratory has been approved as an official EU laboratory). **Please ensure sampling date is completed by Veterinary Practice and the full APHA report which includes the Authorised Responsible Officer's signature or EIA will not be accepted for export.**
 - **IMPORT DOCKET** - If you are importing a horse into the UK for the purpose of selling through Goffs UK, you are required to import the horse on the Goffs UK Ltd EORI number. For this, you will need to sign a Goffs UK Import Docket, a sample of which can be found [here](#). These documents will auto populate with your entry details from your [Goffs UK website account](#) and will be available to complete online upon publication of the catalogue. Please ensure that you select your Transport Company from the dropdown menu before signing the document and returning to saledocuments@goffssuk.com. Please note that these documents are not available for anyone who didn't note on the original entry that the horse will be imported. If this is the case, then please contact saledocuments@goffssuk.com.
 - **UNTRIED 2, 3 & 4 YO's** – Passport with up-to-date Flu vaccinations as above. Health certificate and Negative Equine Infectious Anaemia (EIA) Coggins Certificate as above.
 - **YEARLINGS** – Passport with up-to-date Flu vaccinations as above. Health certificate and Negative Equine Infectious Anaemia (EIA) Coggins Certificate as above.
 - **FOALS** - Passport, including new ePassport. Health certificate and Negative Equine Infectious Anaemia (EIA) Coggins Certificate. Foals of 2022 do not require to have up to date vaccinations.
 - **MARES** – Broodmare Passport (Registered with Weatherbys). Up-to-date Flu vaccinations as above. Pregnancy certificate dated **within 14 days of sale**. EVA (Equine Viral Arteritis) and CEM (Contagious Equine Metritis) Certificates dated **within 30 days of sale** stating that a negative clitoral swab (fossa and sinuses) has been obtained. Health certificate and Negative Equine Infectious Anaemia (EIA) Coggins Certificate as above. Covering Certificates are mandatory and should be electronically lodged with Weatherbys.
 - **BARREN MARES:** Broodmare Passport (Registered with Weatherbys). Up-to-date Flu vaccinations as above. EVA (Equine Viral Arteritis) and CEM (Contagious Equine Metritis) Certificates dated **within 30 days of sale** stating that a negative clitoral swab (fossa and sinuses) has been obtained. Health certificate and Negative Equine Infectious Anaemia (EIA) Coggins Certificate as above. Covering Certificate should be electronically lodged with Weatherbys and Breeding Certificate (attached) dated **within 14 days of sale** are both **mandatory**.
- POTENTIAL BROODMARES:** Passport with up-to-date Flu vaccinations as above. Health certificate and Negative Equine Infectious Anaemia (EIA) Coggins Certificate as above. Breeding Certificate (attached) dated **within 14 days of sale**. Optional EVA (Equine Viral Arteritis) and CEM (Contagious Equine Metritis) Certificates a negative clitoral swab (fossa and sinuses) has been obtained dated **within 30 days of the sale**.
- **BROODMARES COVERED IN A PREVIOUS SEASON:** Same documents as Barren Mares except Covering Certificate is not required.
 - **PRE-SALE VETERINARY CERTIFICATE** - Any Lots being Sold with a Pre-Sales Veterinary Certificate will be vetted by the Panel of Veterinary Surgeons on arrival at Goffs UK Sales Complex.
 - **VETERINARY CERTIFICATE** - If you have opted to sell your horse with a Veterinary Certificate (& subject to **POST** Sale Veterinary Examination by the Panel), you will need to ensure that the horse undergoes a full five-stage examination using the attached Veterinary Certificate ensuring it has been stamped, dated and signed by your Veterinary surgeon **within 14 days of the sale**. **The Vendor must also sign the Seller's Declaration on the same certificate.**

HORSE WELFARE – When on Goffs' premises we insist on the highest standards of welfare and horsemanship. This includes showing each horse care and respect at all times and in every situation including when loading and unloading, entering and exiting stables and when being presented to potential purchasers
